



# Findings from the CDA 2012 Industry Opinion Survey

#### **Survey Overview**


- The online survey was conducted between November 7, 2012 and November 20, 2012 and generally replicated prior surveys conducted in 2010 and 2011.
- Survey population consisted of 353 agriculture leaders including...
  - producer and staff leadership of industry associations and organizations.
  - CSU leadership.
  - Boards, Commissions, and Advisory Councils of the Colorado Department of Agriculture.
- 118 completed surveys were recorded.
- 33% completed response rate.
  - The typical response rate for external surveys is 10% to 15%.






## **Demographics of Respondents**


#### **Occupation**









# Attitudes about Colorado's Food & Agriculture Industry

### Attitude about the Future













